

- We'll look at common issues that projects often overlook




#### Look on the bright side

- Recipe for success




# A typical Dynamics 365 project





# The real Dynamics 365 project








### Get people ready

- What does CRM stand for?
  - Change
  - Requires
  - Management
- Empathise, support, train the impacted user groups
- Everyone is resistant to changes



### Change management

- You need to manage change on every project
- What is meant by change management?


"Change management is a framework for managing the people side of change"

- I used to wonder why my projects weren't successfully adopted
- It is all about the people impacted by your project
- Usually means: training and some emails



## Why change management?

- Projects that incorporate excellent change management are 6 times more likely to be successful
  - 5 times more likely to stay on or ahead of schedule
  - 2 times more likely to stay on or under budget
- Who doesn't want a successful project??







### Change management

- Most Microsoft partners do not incorporate change management into projects
- Highly recommend Prosci change management methodology (prosci.com)
- Get interested in change management!
  - Get training for people in your organisation
  - Microsoft Customer Success Managers
  - Books, community events











#### The project team

- Project management
  - Weak project management leads to uncoordinated dependencies and delay
  - Good Scrum Masters and Product Owners are worth their weight in gold
- Make sure you have the right skills in the team
  - Sufficient depth and breadth
  - Replace people who don't perform
- A team that plays together, stays together
  - Team members should get to know each other
  - A strong team gets through the hard times together
  - Replace people who don't 'gel'



# PROCESS (3)

#### Business requirements

- Your business requirements can make or break your project
- Quality counts this takes time and effort
  - Use trained business analysts
- Requirements impact on:
  - Development productivity
  - Testing
  - User adoption



#### Impact of requirements

Poor requirements can impact the entire project

Requirements Design Development Testing Training



### Non-functional Requirements

- What are non-functional requirements (NFRs)? Examples:
  - Performance
  - Scalability
  - Availability
  - Infrastructure security
  - User experience
- Can cause significant rework and impact your go-live
- Document them treat them the same as functional requirements
- Bake them in from the start!



### Security requirements

- Define personas for all impacted user groups 🤶 🙎 🙎 🧟
- Tag requirements with personas so you can test
- Don't forget non-core users:
  - IT Support
  - Data administrators
  - Internal development team
  - Integration/application users
- Incorporate security requirements from the start



#### Don't forget the project team

- What access do project team members need?
  - Existing environments/data
  - New environments which should they have access to, and when?
  - Integration and data migration teams
- What software licenses do they need?
  - Dynamics 365 when?
  - Infrastructure build
  - Others



### Your project's data

- Data quality
  - Agree quality standards different data sources/formatting/required fields
  - Cleanse data <u>before</u> migration
    - Doesn't get done after go-live
    - Major user adoption impact
- Data ownership
  - Who owns the data you are incorporating into your project?
    - Could be several [conflicting] business areas leads to delay
  - The organisation must define clear ownership and responsibility for quality
  - Data retention rules document as requirements



#### Data migration

- Always harder than you think
  - Often takes 2-3 times longer than planned
- Is dependent upon earlier work can't start without a data model!
- A key project dependency and very common reason for delaying go-live you can't go-live without data
  - Migration becomes a bottleneck






#### There is never enough time

- When things get tough, give the project the opportunity to succeed
- A difficult conversation 💢 = 🐞 🐞
- Consider the cost of failure










#### Measure three times, cut once

Your project is running late - what are the first things to get cut?





#### Go-live


- Time to party..?
- No, get back to work!
- Plan for
  - Bug fixes
  - Data fixes
  - Transition into support
  - Your project team is out the door
  - ! Continue to train people !
  - This is a journey not a destination what next?
- This all costs money make sure it's budgeted for early on
